WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN AN INDOOR SERVICE AND AN OUTDOOR SERVICE?

Indoor Services are held in The Venue. These services have a limited capacity and require pre-registration to attend. Outdoor Services are held in the Parking Lot. Starting December 6, limited Kids Ministry will be available with pre-registration required by the Thursday before both Indoor and Outdoor Services.

HOW DO I KNOW IF IT'S AN INDOOR OR OUTDOOR SERVICE?

WHAT TIMES ARE YOUR INDOOR AND OUTDOOR SERVICES?

Indoor Services start at 9:30 AM. Outdoor Services start at 10 AM. We start streaming the service at 9:30 AM each Sunday.

DO I HAVE TO WEAR A MASK?

Since we are gathering together as one body of all ages and health conditions, masks are required for everyone as a health and safety precaution for our Antioch family. Please wear your mask as you enter, whenever you are standing, and as you exit the building. You may remove your mask when seated, if you desire. If you forget your mask, we have additional ones available for you.

WILL YOU CONTINUE TO STREAM SERVICES ONLINE?

Yes! We understand that some of our Antioch family are comfortable meeting in-person and others are not. We want to serve everyone, so we are continuing to livestream our Sunday Services every week!

WHAT CAN I EXPECT UPON ARRIVING AT CHURCH FOR AN INDOOR SERVICE?

We want to make sure we are going above and beyond for the health and safety of everyone who attends Antioch in person.

To ensure a spacious and sanitized facility, all chairs are spaced apart at a safe distance. Upon arrival, please put on your mask to enter the building. If you forget your mask, we can supply you with one. There will also be a check-in table operated by Antioch staff. This check-in process is in place for us to be able to have a record of who has attended a Sunday service, given the occasion that someone tests positive for COVID-19 and we need to notify those in attendance. You will be greeted by one of our awesome staff members who will be monitoring the doors with masks on and will open the doors for you when you arrive!

After service is over, ushers will dismiss everyone one row at a time. Feel free to connect with friends in the parking lot!

WHAT WILL THE VENUE LOOK LIKE?

The Venue will be set up in a spacious manner with hand sanitizer stations located at each door. Chairs will be set up in rows with extra space between each row. An usher will seat each household six-feet apart from other households.

All bulletins, connection cards, envelopes, and pens have been removed, and we encourage all guests to fill out a digital connection card and, for those participating in giving, to give online. For those who would like to give by check/cash, we will have a Nathan box at the exit.

WILL THERE BE COMMUNION AND/OR MINISTRY TIME?

During Indoor Services, we will continue to serve and offer communion with self-enclosed communion cups placed below chairs before the service. During Outdoor Services, staff or volunteers will be gloved and handing out self-enclosed communion cups.

There will be no traditional ministry time at this time. We strongly encourage you to pray together with your family and those you come with on Sunday mornings.

WILL THE NURSING MOM'S ROOM BE OPEN?

The Nursing Mom's room will be available in the office space to the right of the Wedgwood hair salon.

WILL ANTIOCH BE SANITIZED BEFORE/AFTER SERVICES?

Yes! Our amazing cleaning crew works hard to clean and sanitize the building for your safety, and is taking additional measures to ensure a sanitized environment.

IS ANY PHYSICAL CONTACT ALLOWED?

We are a friendly church; however, we want to show love and respect to everyone who physically attends Antioch. For the first couple of phases, we are strongly encouraging no physical contact with people, out of precaution and understanding of each other's concerns during this time.

CAN I INVITE A GUEST?

Absolutely! As long as they are comfortable with the re-entry guidelines, register for the service, and are not running a fever or have been exposed to COVID-19.

I HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH COVID. CAN I ATTEND A SERVICE IN PERSON?

Out of the abundance of caution, if you have been exposed to someone with COVID in the past 14 days, we ask that you continue to join us for worship online through [YouTube](#) and [Facebook](#) at this time.
