#### WHAT'S HAPPENING ON SUNDAYS?

Sunday worship services will be held in the parking lot at 10 AM until further notice. The parking lot opens at 9:30 AM. AKids classrooms open at 9:45 AM. Worship and the online livestream start at 10 AM. In case of inclement weather, we will move into the Venue for two indoor services at 9:30 AM and 11 AM.

#### HOW DO I KNOW IF YOU'RE MOVING INDOORS?

Members will be notified via email and/or text, and the information will be shared on social media.

#### DO I HAVE TO WEAR A MASK?

When attending an in-person event, we encourage masks unless seated.

#### IS ANY PHYSICAL CONTACT ALLOWED?

We are a friendly church; however, we want to show love and respect to everyone who physically attends Antioch. We are strongly encouraging asking for permission before hugging or touching others, out of precaution and understanding of each other's concerns during this time.

#### WILL THERE BE KIDS CLASSES ON SUNDAYS?

We are offering classes for Babies-Elementary on Sundays. If you'd like to place your child in an AKids class, please register them on our **EVENTS** page. Check the **VISIT ANTIOCH** page for more details on new classroom locations and protocols.

#### WILL THE NURSING MOMS ROOM BE OPEN?

The Nursing Moms room will be available in the office to the right of the Wedgwood hair salon.

#### WILL THERE BE COMMUNION AND/OR MINISTRY TIME?

Staff or volunteers will be gloved and handing out self-enclosed communion cups. At this time, there will be no traditional ministry time. We strongly encourage you to pray together with your family and those you come with on Sunday mornings.

#### WILL YOU CONTINUE TO STREAM SERVICES ONLINE?

Yes, we are continuing to livestream our Sunday Services every week at 10 AM.

#### DO I HAVE TO RSVP TO COME TO AN INDOOR SERVICE?

In case of inclement weather and we have to move our Sunday service indoors, registration is recommended as there is limited space in the Venue. Registration links can be found HERE!

#### WHAT DOES THE VENUE LOOK LIKE FOR AN INDOOR SERVICE?

An Antioch staff member will check you in as you enter the building. This process is in place for us to be able to have a record of who has attended an indoor service, should someone who attends test positive for COVID-19 and we need to notify those in attendance.

The Venue will be set up in a spacious manner with hand sanitizer stations located at each door. Chairs will be set up in rows with extra space between each row.

All bulletins, connection cards, envelopes, and pens have been removed, and we encourage guests to fill out a digital connection card and, for those participating in giving, to give online. For those who would like to give by check/cash, we will have a Nathan box at the exit.

#### WILL ANTIOCH BE SANITIZED BEFORE/AFTER SERVICES?

Yes! Our amazing cleaning crew works hard to clean and sanitize the building for your safety, and is taking additional measures to ensure a sanitized environment.

#### CAN I INVITE A GUEST?

Absolutely, we love meeting new faces!

## I HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH COVID. CAN I ATTEND A SERVICE IN-PERSON?
